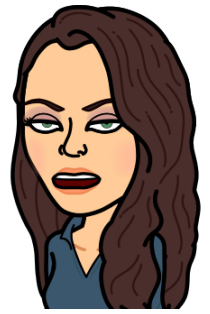

What if... I forget my homework at home?

When you get home on Friday you must send a picture of it to me via Remind or email by 3:00 PM. If you do not, you will lose points on your homework grade for missing work.

What if... I don't understand how to do something?

Come to school the next day and ask me! What's great about weekly homework is that if you don't understand something, you can ask me ahead of time before it is due on Friday. If it is Thursday night and you are stumped, all I ask is that you try your hardest. Leave that question blank if you have to. No, I will not accept homework that is blank or with a bunch of question marks all over it. *It's okay to not know but it's not okay to not try.* You can also stay after with me on Tuesdays for extra help! My suggestion-look at the homework on Monday when you get it so you know what you might get stuck on.

What if... I didn't do my homework?

Then I am going to cry. No I am kidding (maybe). Then you will lose 5 points off of your homework grade. A grade that is SO EASILY managed just by passing in your homework on time. You have an entire WEEK to do it. If this becomes a habit, home will be notified.

What if... my dog ate my homework?

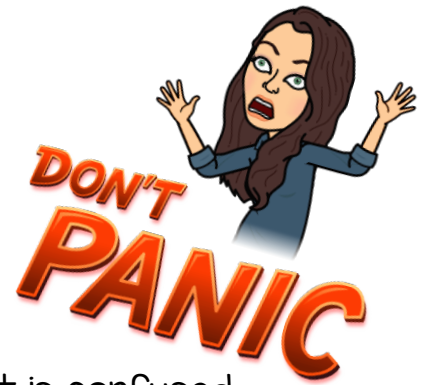
